### **Programming Devices**

#### **General Information**

The Device programming option can be used to trigger device, send Follow-Me or E-mail messages of system events. Up to 16 devices can be programmed. Devices 1 through 8 are used for Triggers and Follow-Me Messages and Devices 9 through 16 are used for E-mail events. Check with your Installer to see which options are available to you.

3. Select the "Devices" icon. The system displays the Devices screen.

4. Select a "Device" key followed by the Edit button. The system displays a keyboard.

- 5. If desired you can enter a Device Name. Select the "Clear" key and then enter up to 13 characters of text.
- Note: Select the "ABC..." key to switch the keyboard between upper/lower case or the "123!@#" key to switch to numbers.
- 6. Once you are finished, select "Done". The system returns to the Device screen.
- Select the "Type" button. Dependant upon what features are programmed in your control the system toggles between the following options: Disabled
