
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

MOUNTING THE CP-120

Depress the latch with a screwdriver to separate the two covers.

Secure the rear cover to the wall with the screws provided. If the wall is made of drywall or plaster, drill holes into the wall and install the plastic screw in-

Align the hooking pins and latch on the rear cover with the front cover. Press firmly. The two covers will lock into place.




WIRING THE CP-120

Pass the 6-wire telco cable through the opening in the rear cover and connect to phone jack ${\sf J1}.$

All connections, including power, are made through the telco cable. The CP-120 is supplied with a 25 ft. cable. Cable length should not exceed 200 ft.



If your application requires a longer cable, use the diagram below for making a replacement cable:



Use RJ11 connector.
