# **E** Helping Visitors To Call You

When you have visitors, they can find your name and call you by following the directions on the display screen at the building entrance.

You may have been given a tenant code. If you are expecting visitors, you can tell them the code. Your visitors can enter the code on the keypad to call you.



# **E** Talking to Visitors

When visitors call you from the building entrance your telephone will ring. When you answer the telephone you can talk to the visitors for a limited period of time. You will hear a long warning tone on the telephone when you have 10 seconds left to talk to the visitors.



### **Opening the Door for Visitors**

To open the main door for visitors:

when they call you from the building entrance, dial [7] on your telephone. The speaker beeps once per second while the door is unlocked, and the display shows:

> Door Unlocked, Please Enter.

To open an alternate entrance (such as a car gate) for visitors:

when they call you from the alternate entrance, dial |9| on your telephone (touch-tone telephones only).

### **Entering the Building Using Your Entry Access Code**

You may have been given an entry access code for the building. To open the building entrance using the entry access code:

- \* on the keypad. 1. Press
- Enter your 4 or 6-digit entry access code. The speaker beeps once per 2. second while the door is unlocked, and the display shows:

Door Unlocked, Please Enter.

**NOTE**: Do not give your entry access code to anybody.
