

#### DESCRIPTION

The KD-90 control station is a digital keypad designed for use with Linear's CP-90 Supervised Wireless Control/Communicator. The keypad allows the user to arm, disarm and interrogate the security system. The installer can also program the CP-90 from the KD-90 keypad.

Connection to the CP-90 is made through a 4-wire cable. Multiple keypads can be connected to the CP-90 without having to homerun each of the keypad's wires. The KD-90 keypad downlights, display backlights and display contrast levels are adjustable.

The keypad has three 24-hour fire, medical and police buttons for emergency activation.

The keypad sounds a chirp as each key is pressed and audible alarm signals and sirens sound from the built-in speaker.


#### **FEATURES**

- Displays system status and information on a two-line alphanumeric display.
- \* Display can be customized by installer for each installation.
- \* Shows sensor and system condition on eight LED displays.
- \* Sounds system tones, beeps and local alarm sirens.
- \* Twelve keys for arming, disarming and changing security levels.
- \* STATUS and BYPASS keys for interrogating sensors and special arming.
- \* Three 24-hour activation keys for fire, medical, and police emergency alarms.
- \* Built-in tamper switch to signal keypad removal from its mounting plate.


#### IMPORTANT!

To trigger a 24-hour emergency zone with the KD-90, the desired emergency key (fire, medical, police) must be held down for at least four seconds.


**STEP 1** Remove mounting plate. Twist a screwdriver into slots on bottom edge of case to remove the mounting plate.




**STEP 2** *Install mounting plate.* Attach the mounting plate to a single or double gang electrical box, or use the four screws and plastic anchors to mount the plate directly to wallboard.




**STEP 3** Connect wiring to CP-90. Run 22 AWG or larger four-conductor wire between the keypad location and the CP-90 control panel. Loop the wire two times through the ferrite doughnut as shown. Multiple keypads do not have to be homerun wired.



**STEP 4** Plug in cable connector and mount keypad. Insert the cable plug into the keyed connector on the back of the KD-90. Hook the keypad onto the mounting plate, starting at the top edge first, then pressing the bottom in until it snaps tight.



**STEP 5** Program keypad and test. If this is the primary keypad for the system, when the CP-90 is powered up the keypad will be accessory #65. If this is an additional keypad to the primary, it must be installed into the CP-90's memory. Referring to the CP-90 Programming Instructions, set the keypad lighting levels. Adjust the display contrast by holding down \* and pressing 0-7 (0 = high, 7 = low contrast). Test the keypad by arming and disarming the system to each of the security levels. To test the emergency buttons, press and hold each button for four seconds.
