The following pages detail the steps necessary to program the GEM-P1632 Panel. Programming is divided into two areas, *Easy Program Mode* and *Address Program Mode*:

ENTER THE EASY PROGRAMMING MENU

Enable Burg Output Chirp on KeyFob?

Press NO to proceed

Enable SIA CP-01 Features?

Press NO to proceed.

Enter the Number of Keypads

- Factory set for 1 Keypad
- Enter 02 for 2 Keypads, 03 for 3, etc., and press I to save.
- · Press NEXT to proceed.

Program Central Station Receiver Telephone Number

- Press 1 through 9P for digits 1–9; * 0 for a zero. and press to save.
- Press NEXT to proceed.

Program Central Station Account Number

- Press 1 through 9P for digits 1–9 and press to save.
- Press NEXT to proceed.

Program Central Station Format

- Press <u>*</u> <u>2</u> for a Contact ID and press <u>to save</u>.
- Press the NEXT button to proceed.

Program User Codes

- Enter User Number, press MENU, Enter User Code, press to save.
- After entering all Arm/Disarm Codes, program Ambush Code as follows:
- Enter User Number 32, press MENU, enter 2580, press MENU MENU, enter 05 to designate Ambush Code, press 11 to save.

Enroll Wireless Transmitters

- Before enrolling transmitters, the GEM-RECVG wireless receiver and all wireless transmitters should be installed.
- Enter the zone number to which the transmitter point will be mapped.
- 1. Press [BYPASS] to enter the Enroll Mode. The red and green LEDs on the keypad will flash and the window will display ENROLL as shown at left.
- 2. For the GEM-TRANS2, open the door or window connected to the point that is to be learned.
- 3. Install the transmitter battery. The keypad will beep to indicate that the point has been successfully enrolled and the transmitter's RF ID number will appear in the display...
- 4. Repeat steps 1-4 to learn additional transmitters.
- 5. Press NEXT to proceed.

Program Wireless Keyfobs

Enter:

- The Key Fob Transmitter number (01–08) [MENU].
- The Area Number (1).
- The 6-digit RF ID # and 1-digit checksum number printed on the transmitter and box.
- The Aux 1 Option (see key fob A1 & A2 options).
- The Aux 2 Option (see key fob A1 & A2 options).
- Press to save.
- Press NEXT to proceed when all key fobs have been entered.

NOTE: When programming the RF ID Code number, "0" through "9" = 0 through [A = [*] 0; B = [*] 1; C = [*] 2; D = [*] 3; E = [*] 4 ; and "F" = 🖌 5 .



EXIT EASY PROGRAMMING MENU: This completes the Easy Programming Menu. Press **THESET** to enter Address Program Mode for further programming.

NOTE: IF FOR ANY REASON YOU WISH TO CLEAR ALL PROGRAMMING FROM THE CONTROL PANEL AND RESTART PROGRAM MODE, USE THE FOLLOWING "CLEAR PROGRAM" FUNCTIONS WHILE IN ADDRESS PROGRAM MODE.

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CLEAR DEALER PROGRAM (ERASES DEALER PROGRAM)

ARNING This function erases the dealer program. Use this feature to clear all system programming and re-start program mode from scratch. All system programming is erased while Scheduled Data and Zone Descriptions are maintained.

• Press MENU 2285, then press I. Press RESET to exit program mode.



COLD START (ERASES ENTIRE PROGRAM)

RNING This function erases the entire program including system programming, Zone Descriptions and Schedules.

• Press MENU 2286, then press . Press RESET to exit program mode

DIRECT ADDRESS PROGRAMMING

A: SET ALARM OUTPUT TIMEOUT

Go to Address 1414 and enter 10 minutes (010).

- 1. Press 1 4 1 4 to access Address 1414.
- 2. Press 0 1 0.
- 3. Press to save.

B:ENABLE LOW BATTERY REPORT



Go to Address 0841 and enter 5 to enable a global low battery event report. See the chart below.

- 1. Press MENU 0 8A 4 1 to access Address 0841.
- 2. Press <u>5</u> to enable a low battery event report.
- 3. Press to save.

Go to Address 0861 and enter 1, 3, 4 to enable reporting for keypad events Ambush and Keypad Panic.

- 1. Press MENU 0 BA 6 1 to access Address 0861.
- 2. Press 1 3 4 to enable Ambush and Keypad Panic and disable Keypad Fire and Keypad Aux.

3. Press [1] to save.

Go to Address 1440 and press 3, 5 to enable keypad options for Keypad Panic and Ambush for each keypad in the system. See the chart below.

- 2. Press 3 5 to disable Keypad Fire and Keypad Aux., and enable Keypad Panic and Ambush options.

3. Repeat for each keypad in the system. Press I to save.

E: Enable Keypad Set Time/Date Message

Go to Address 2051 and enter 1 to enable the keypad Set Time/Date Message option. See the chart below.

- 2. Press to save.

SET CENTRAL STATION ZONE REPORTING OPTIONS 1:

All zones default to Burglary. Zones programmed as Fire zones will automatically report as fire zones. All other zone report codes must be changed manually by entering the Address number and selecting the report code for the zone type .

If you selected your fire zones in the Easy Programming Menu (see page 1), and do not have any other zone types as listed below, no further programming is required and this step may be skipped.
