1.0 Issue

If you have D6412 or D4412 Control Panels with the EPROM versions listed above (refer to *Figure 1* for the version location), pressing the [CMD] key followed by [9] [5] causes a System Fault. The control panel could notify the central station of a system failure, reset the date and time, and fill the Event Log with invalid events.

Pressing [CMD] [9] [5] does not harm the control panel or system in any way. It will continue to operate normally.
