Readykey for Windows

Photo ID

Readykey for Windows now offers a Photo ID module where scanned images are stored and displayed in the Personnel application. A sample screen is shown below. By linking to a suitable printer, ID cards can be produced with users details taken directly from the Readykey for Windows personnel database.

When using Readykey proximity ID cards it is recommended that the images are printed onto a self adhesive laminate which is then attached to the proximity card. The cards can then be reused if any details change.

Printing directly onto proximity ID cards is possible, but please contact Radionics regarding the suitability of cards for printing.

Requirements

Hardware

You require Pentium, 133-MHz or greater with at least 16Mb RAM, 3.5" floppy disk drive, 500Mb to 1Gb hard disk, super VGA monitor, Loronix video capture card with color CCD camera and lens, scanner or remote video capture device.

Tripod and suitable lighting are also required.

Software

Microsoft Windows for workgroups 3.11 or Windows 95 and Readykey for Windows version 3.2 with Photo ID module.

Loronix Image Share II software.
