The information in this article applies to:

- * Readykey for Windows Version 3.X
- * Microsoft Windows for Workgroups 3.11
- * Microsoft Windows 95

General

- All PCs which are to be used for running Readykey for Windows must have Microsoft Windows for Workgroups 3.11 or Windows 95 installed.
- Network DDE must be enabled on all PCs.
- It is recommended that all PCs are in the same workgroup.
- Network Card: Radionics recommends the use of a branded network card, such as an Intel EtherExpress or 3COM Etherlink III.
- Radionics recommends that a Server-based network be used whenever possible, as it includes a dedicated File Server designed to provide shared resources.

However, in circumstances where a network is not available, a peer to peer network may be used. In this case, it is recommended that the Readykey Server be dedicated to being a Readykey for Windows Server for administration of the Readykey for Windows System, and not be used for other tasks - e.g. word processing, etc. or a reduction in speed and performance can be expected.

Server- Based

- Any Server-based network can be used that supports access by Windows for Workgroups or Windows 95.
- A maximum of 20 Readykey for Windows workstations may be used to run Readykey for Windows at one time.

Peer to Peer

- The only peer to peer network supported is Microsoft's Windows for Workgroups 3.11 or Windows 95.
- A maximum of 4 PCs (including the PC designated as the Readykey Server) may be used at any one time.
- The Readykey Server should be dedicated to being a Readykey for Windows Server for administration of the Readykey for Windows System, and not be used for other tasks - e.g. word processing, etc. or a reduction in speed and performance can be expected.
