- * Microsoft Windows for Workgroups 3.11
- * Microsoft Windows 95

General

- This document outlines how to replace the existing operator records with the "Default Operator" record that contains one operator.
- It may be necessary to do this if the logins have been forgotten or all authority levels are too low to properly administer the system.
- At any time during this process you need assistance, please call Readykey Technical Support at 1-800-538-5807.

Process

- A. Close the Readykey for Windows. (This may require you to reboot the PC if you cannot close the login screen.)
- B. Go to Main: File Manager or Start: Programs: Windows Explorer.
- C. Find the directory titled **RKEYWIN** and highlight it with your mouse.
- D. Rename **RKEYWIN** to **RKEYOLD**.
- E. Install a Standalone copy of Readykey for Windows. Ensure you install the same version of this program that is running on this machine. Install the software in the default directory of **C:\RKEYWIN**.
- F. Go back to Main: File Manager or Start: Programs: Windows Explorer.
- G. Click on **RKEYWIN**. Click on **DATA**. Click on **BOPERATR.DAT**. Copy **BOPERATR.DAT** to **RKEYOLD\DATA**.



- H. Click on RKEYWIN. Click on DATA. Click on BPRIVS.DAT. Copy BPRIVS.DAT to RKEYOLD\DATA.
- I. Find the directory of **RKEYWIN** and highlight it with your mouse.
- J. Rename **RKEYWIN** to **RKEYNEW**.
- K. Find the directory of **RKEYOLD** and highlight it with your mouse.
- L. Rename **RKEYOLD** to **RKEYWIN**.
- M. Exit File Manager or Windows Explorer.
- N. Start Readykey for Windows. Login as "GUEST" tab "GUEST".
- O. Re-enter all the operator information as needed.
