1. INTRODUCTION

The RFT-1 is a general purpose, miniature low-power transmitter module, designed for digital data transfer on UHF radio channels. Its main application is transmission of digital data in remote control systems and RF data links, using the Visonic Ltd. RFR-1 receiver modules at the receiving end.

The transmitter accepts a serial, CMOS level data input. The standard model is equipped with a 4-terminal, right-angle board-to board connector for the DC and data inputs as well as for the RF output. Another version with a straight pin header is also available upon special request (see Figures 2 and 3). An external antenna wire (up to 28 cm) is required, or alternatively, a printed antenna strip must be provided on the host system motherboard.






Figure 1. The RFT-1 Module

The PCB-mounted headers are 4-position, single-row, board-to-board connectors with 2.54 mm (0.100") pitch and 0.64 mm (0.25") square pins.
